The [ARI Grant Program](#) is a state-funded initiative designed to support the implementation of on-farm conservation practices that help reduce greenhouse gas emissions and improve air and water quality. Through this program, California farmers and ranchers can apply for funding to help implement practices that reduce soil erosion, improve water efficiency, and enhance soil health.

In 2021, the state of California announced that \$200,000 in funding will be invested in ARI grant projects. These projects will help support sustainable agriculture practices and reduce greenhouse gas emissions through the implementation of conservation practices.

In total, these projects are expected to sequester approximately 1860 MT CO₂eq, which is equivalent to the carbon sequestered by 2,200 acres of U.S. forests per year.

In 2021, the state of California awarded \$451,214 in HSP funding to projects in Santa Clara County. This is equivalent to the carbon released from the energy use of 200 homes per year.
